

Endorsement at a Glance: IMH-E® and ECMH-E®

- Both the Infant Mental Health Endorsement® (IMH-E®) and the Early Childhood Mental Health Endorsement® (ECMH-E®) are based on competencies designed to support the growth of culturally-sensitive, relationship-focused infant and early childhood practices. An Endorsement® applicant shows understanding of these competencies through their individual education, work experience, specialized training, and reflective practice experience.

Infant Mental Health (IMH-E®)

Specialized work experience with children **birth - age 3** & their families

IMH-E® shows that professionals have work experience and expertise with families and children from prenatal period through first 3 years.



Early Childhood Mental Health (ECMH-E®)

Specialized in work experience with **3-6 year olds** & their families

ECMH-E® shows that professionals have attained a specific level of work experience and expertise with children ages 3-6 and their families.

Both IMH-E® and ECMH-E® are important for professionals in early care and education, prevention and early intervention, home visiting, healthcare, child welfare, mental health, policy, academia, and many others.
